I. Homeroom Supply List

For Homeroom Use:

- a. Two boxes of tissues
- b. One roll of paper towels
- c. Two packages of dry erase markers
- d. One package antibacterial wipes

For Student Use:

- e. 3-ring pencil bag (this needs to be brought to every class)
- f. Blue and black erasable pens
- g. Red pens
- h. Highlighters
- i. Mechanical pencils with erasers
- j. Homework assignment book (preferably one with dates already in it)
- k. Bible

II. Trigonometry and Pre-Calc

VIII. Health

The science project is optional for Health students. Students who decide to do the science project must complete the summer science assignment. Those students who wish to complete a science project will receive extra credit for their work and will be eligible to compete in outside science competitions. The decision to complete this project must be made this summer:

- a. One 1" 3-ring binder
- b. One spiral bound notebook (that fits into binder) (**non perforated pages**)
- c. One 3-hole file folder with pocket
- d. Soft book cover (jumbo size)
- e. Clear contact paper to cover workbook
- f. (Optional): The following supplies are needed for those students wishing to complete a science project. Please read the **Summer Science Project Assignment** on the school web site.
 - i. One 1" 3-ring binder
 - ii. One 3-hole file folder with pocket
 - iii. One trifold self standing **foam** fold out presentation board (36"H x 48"W)
