School

Calvary Chapel Academy is a private Christian school currently enrolling 156 students from grades Pre-K through 12th Grade. This year there are currently 40 students enrolled in grades 9 through 12. The school opened in the Fall of 2004 and graduated the first senior class in the Spring of 2010.

Curriculum

The academic program at the High School level is organized in a rotating schedule. Students take seven, forty-two minute classes during the day with specialized teachers in each of the various academic classes. Students have the option of taking College Prep or Honors classes.

AP® classes are offered in Calculus AB and US History. The Advanced Placement program is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in Algebra II, Biology, Chemistry, English, Geometry, Physics, Spanish III, Trigonometry/Pre-Calculus and U.S. History.

GPA Calculation

Students receive a numeric grade for each class each term. The numeric grade is then translated into a weighted GPA based off the scoring key above. Major classes are worth one credit and are weighted twice as much in the GPA calculation.

If a student achieves a GPA of 4.0 or above for an academic year, any non-assigned elective classes will not be included in the student's GPA calculation for that year. This adjustment will be made before the distribution of 4th term report cards and may adjust the student's GPA for previous terms that year.
