*	1	Rubbermaid plastic container for all Supplies (Please provide a standard shoebox size container to accommodate your child's supplies. Thank you!)
	1	Bible – Picture Bible is fine
	2	Folders with inside bottom pockets
	1	Box of 24 Crayola Crayons – Less expensive brands are not true to color and they tend to clump
	1	10 or 12 Pack of Markers
	1	Box of 24-count Colored Pencils
	10	Glue Sticks
	1	Pair of Scissors
	5	Sharpened Pencils (Standard yellow #2 pencils are the best. No decorated pencils please as they are difficult to sharpen plus no pencil sharpeners)
	3	Large Pink Rectangle Erasers (No animal or character shapes please)
	1	Complete Change of Clothes and undergarments. Place in a clear, labeled Ziploc bag. Please no shorts or summer clothing. Pants, and shirts with change of socks.
	1	Beach Towel for rest time (please no blankets. No large Sleeping bags please.)
	1	Large Box of Tissues
	1	12 oz. or Large Bottle of Hand Sanitizer
	1	Large Container of Clorox Disinfectant Wipes for Wiping Down Tables and Chairs.

Notes: Please supply your child with a snack and lunch each day, including any necessary utensils (e.g., fork, spoon, napkins). Please include drinks for both snack and lunch times. Additionally, include a bottle of water for the classroom. Many times, the kids come in from recess thirsty, and their drinks are either finished or down in the lunchroom. Healthy snacks are encouraged! Please refrain from bringing candy or high-sugar snacks if possible. Suggestions include carrot or celery sticks with dip, hummus, cream cheese, peanut butter, cheese and crackers, pretzels, fruit, or snack bars, as well as yogurts.

Kindergarten students are required to wear sneakers or bring them to school every day. They cannot play in the gym without them, and they will not be able to attend gym class on Fridays if they do not have them. Thank you for being helpful in this area.

Optional: Treasure box items (inexpensive small toys, games, puzzles, stickers, or craft items). No candy or gum, please. These treasures are given as rewards for completing work, maintaining neat work, demonstrating good behavior, showing helpfulness and exhibiting acts of kindness.
